Composition

The composition of the Scientific Committee SIVE is intended to extensively represent the entire universe of Italian and foreign wine research centers. It is chaired by prof. Emilio Celotti, SIVE President.

Are invited to join the Scientific Committee:

- scientists who have been composing the SC of the previous prize edition, listed below, to whom SIVE extends sincere thanks for their efforts
- all researchers in the public sector - Italians and foreigners - who declare their availability **by December 21, 2018** by sending an e-mail to the President of the SC (emilio.celotti@uniud.it) or to the Secretariat SIVE (sive@vinidea.it) specifying their affiliation and position in the organization.

Activity

The SIVE Scientific Committee will evaluate the research works that candidate to the two SIVE Awards 2019:

- ✓ ASSOENOLOGI – limited to Italian researchers, and
- ✓ OENOPPIA – open to the whole international academic community.

The evaluation process will take place entirely via the Internet in the month of January 2019: SC components will have access to the abstracts of the candidate researches (made anonymous), and will judge them for the criterion “*degree of innovation and interest of the topic*”.

The total number of applicants is expected to range between 50 and 70; although, each SC component is free of evaluating all candidates to both SIVE Awards, or simply judging the applicants of one of the two prizes, or only those involving scientific disciplines within its competence.

The researches at the top of the rank formed in this phase will be invited to give an oral presentation at Enoforum 2019 and will get a step forward in the competition for the Awards.

The SC component will be solicited again in June 2019 to validate the scientific value of the Finalists i.e. the five works - for each of the two Awards - best judged by the Enoforum delegates who attend the presentations. SC components will have available a manuscript for each Finalist, and/or the video of the presentation give at Enoforum by the author.

The components of the SIVE SC can candidate for the prizes one or more researches performed by their own or by the group to which they belong, but should abstain from their evaluation, that in any case would not be taken into account when computing the rankings.

Membership in the SIVE SC does not provide any compensation or reimbursement, but its members are entitled for free admission to Enoforum 2019 congresses, both physically or on streaming, and will have late free access to recordings of all conference sessions, including presentations not related to SIVE Awards.
